Special Care Notes: (*examples*)

Medications: K9 Advantix II for parasite preventative given on the 1st of every month (*kept in K9 First Aid Kit in hall closet*)

Shots: Always Current (*please see "Shots & License" blinder tab*)

Allergies: Fleas (*if skin irritation occurs, please give her 75 milligrams of Benadryl with food and treat the infected area with 1 teaspoon of pure bleach and 1 cup of water diluted- this will be in the K9 First Aid Kit that is labeled and stored in mid-hall closet next to bathroom on the lower shelf*)

Food Sensitivities/Allergies: Corn, Wheat, Gluten, Soy, Beef, Rye, Barley and by-products

Food: Blue Buffalo Co. Fish and Sweet Potato Adult Basics (*1 cup AM with 1 vitamin supplied near food and 1 cup PM – food stored in kitchen near China hutch*)

Treats: Blue Buffalo Co. (*all ok expect beef/bacon*), FreshPet 'refrigerator' treats, Fruitables, natural ingredient treats, etc. (*treats stored in kitchen freezer*)

Other: Dog is a working Medical Response Service Dog. Dog's vest and leash are usually kept in owner's car or hanging up in the home front entry way.
